GUIDELINES

The Chinese Benevolent Association (CBA) will award eight tuition assistance grants to needy students who must maintain a minimum GPA of a "B" in academic performance.

The student must be of Chinese descent as defined in the membership requirements of the CBA but may not necessarily be a member of the CBA.

These awards are only for one year, but awardees may apply each successive year during their course of study.

The decision of the Scholarship Committee is final and the Committee is not required to give any explanation or justification of its decision.

Any student, family member or friends of the applicant student that attempts to influence any member of the CBA SYS Scholarship Committee may lead to the disqualification of that student from obtaining any assistance.

Tuition assistance is provided to students with a demonstrated financial need who will maintain an acceptable educational performance, participate in community service activities and sustain reputable personal behavior. Students already receiving scholarships and /or assistance from other sources or organizations may not qualify for assistance. The total budget for 2010 is \$640,000.

I. ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

Recipients of the Sun Yat Sen tuitions assistance award are required to:

- A. Be of Chinese decent. The student and/or parents do not have to be members of the CBA.
- B. Must be residing in Jamaica for at last one year but not necessarily a Jamaican citizen.
- C. Complete the Application from. All questions must be answered and must be hand written.
- D. Be enrolled fulltime or part-time in college or school.
- E. Pursuing CXC, CAPE, Degree or any other academic courses that the Committee may deem to be fit.
- F. Achieve and maintain a minimum "B" academic standard
- G. Must perform voluntary or community work (for at least one month), this work must be approved by the Scholarship Committee.
- H. Submit copies of academic records from all schools attended past and present.
- Write an essay about yourself, your family background, personal interest, what you plan to study and why you want to further your education.
- J. Attend an interview with the Scholarship Committee

II. SELECTION RECIPIENTS

Selections will be based on the student's overall academic progress, financial need, extracurricular activities, leadership skills, and participation in community activities.

III. DEADLINE FOR APPLICATION FOR AWARDS

Applications must be submitted by July 15, 2010 and successful applicants will be notified of tuition assistance awards by July 31, 2010.

IV. RENEWAL OF ASSISTANCE AWARDS

Assistance awards will not be renewed automatically on an academic year or semester basis. Students must reapply each year.

V. REVOCATION OF ASSISTANCE

The Scholarship Committee reserves the right to cancel any tuition assistance awards at any time if the student fails to meet the standards of academic progress, or commits any behavior or actions that the Committee deems to be unfit, or falsifies any reported information.
